Cohen is a polite student. He displays a great attitude and is always helpful. Cohen leads by example and is a positive role model for his peers.



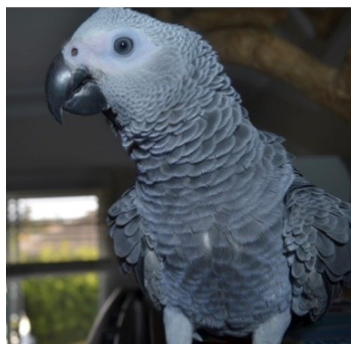

CONGRATULATIONS CHLOE

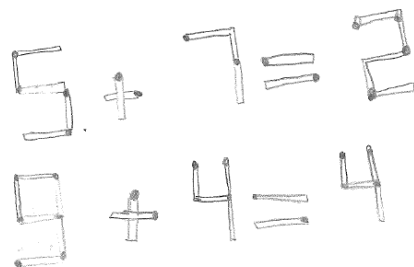
