**Brodie Bokor, 3/4B**

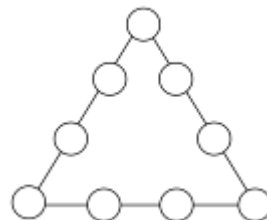
For being a positive, productive and friendly student. Brodie consistently demonstrates our school's values and listens to teacher instructions.
