Paint the Town REaD

Let's all read, talk, sing and rhyme with children from birth

Paint The Town REaD is an early literacy whole community scheme that encourages the whole of community to read, talk, sing, play and rhyme with children from birth, so that they are ready for reading and writing at school. First developed in the NSW town of Parkes in the 1990's, Paint the Town REaD now takes its



message across Australia. St Marys South Public School is proud to have been handed the Paint the Town Read Relay baton. Our students will host the relay baton as it is passed

from class to class. As the baton enters the classroom students will stop what they are doing and join together to read.

Paint the Town REaD, relay baton began in Western Australia's Parliament House on March 20, eventually the Reading baton will finish on the shores of the Pacific in Wollongong. The baton will be stopping at communities en route to celebrate with families the importance of reading with their children right from birth.
