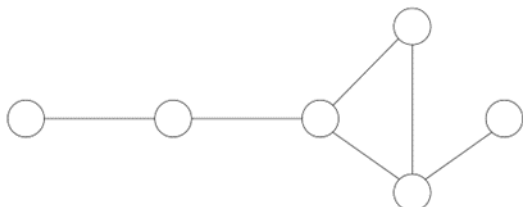




## WONDER - STEM PROBLEM OF THE WEEK
