## ONLINE PAYMENTS

**Online payments are the preferred way to make payments for any school run activity.**



Parent online payments (POP) provides parents with a secure payment facility to deposit into the school's account via a credit or debit card. It gives parent/carers a convenient and alternative means of paying the school.

Online payments can be made using either a Visa or MasterCard credit or debit card, and can be made via computer, tablet or mobile phone. The payment page is accessed from the front page of the schools website by selecting [\\$ Make a payment](#).

Items that can be paid include voluntary school contributions, excursions and creative and practical arts activities (these include band and dance). There is also a category called 'Other' this to cover items not covered in the previous headings, Other can be used to make a complete payment of a school invoice.

When you access the [\\$ Make a payment](#) you must enter:

the students name, and class and reference number  
OR the students name, and date of birth.

These details are entered each time you make a payment as student information is not held within the payment system.

This is a secure payment system hosted by Westpac to ensure that your credit/debit card details are captured in a secure manner, these details are not passed back to the school. For any enquiries regarding the Online Payment process please contact the School Administration Office.

- Allocate a drawer or area of the kitchen where lunch boxes and containers are kept, making them handy to find come packing time.

## AUTHOR VISIT - MATT STANTON

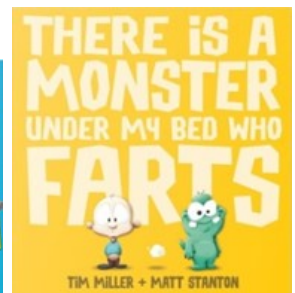
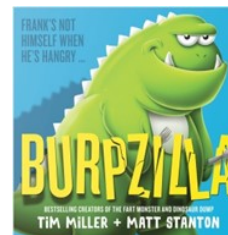


On Wednesday, 21st August, we had the pleasure of meeting Author, Matt Stanton.
